
Ghana's Cocoa Production

An Overview


- 1.9 million Ha of Cocoa Farms in Ghana
- 1.1 million Ha is productive
- 40% Diseased or Moribund
- >315,000 Ha affected with CSSVD
- >200,000 Ha is Moribund
- CSSVD reducing yield by about 70%
- CSSVD causing death of cocoa trees within 2–3 years of infection
- Average cocoa ۲ **Ghana Cocoa Industry** production 4.8m 850k farmers employed Ŵorld Agricultural 23% 3.7m Contribution to GDP 77% Africa 850k **3%** GDP as Cocoa Exports Ghana 22%




Declining Cocoa Production Levels






Extent of CSSVD Infestation and Treatment

CSSVD OUTBREAK AREAS




