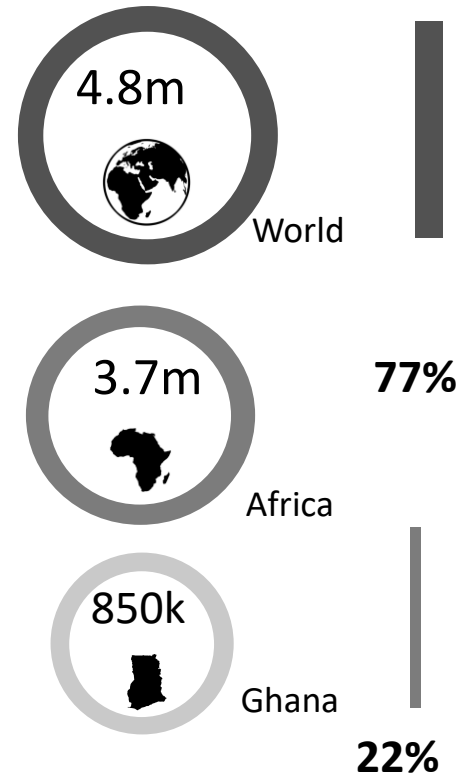


# Ghana's Cocoa Production

## An Overview

- 1.9 million Ha of Cocoa Farms in Ghana
- 1.1 million Ha is productive
- 40% Diseased or Moribund
- >315,000 Ha affected with CSSVD
- >200,000 Ha is Moribund
- CSSVD reducing yield by about 70%
- CSSVD causing death of cocoa trees within 2–3 years of infection

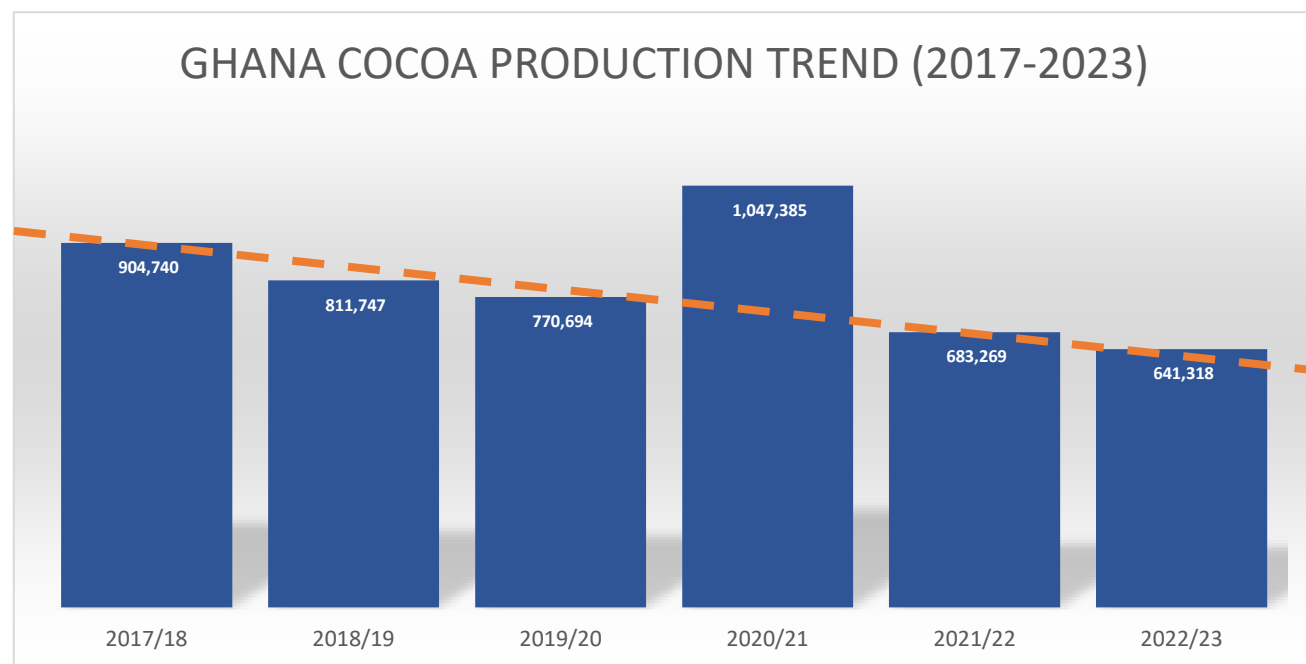

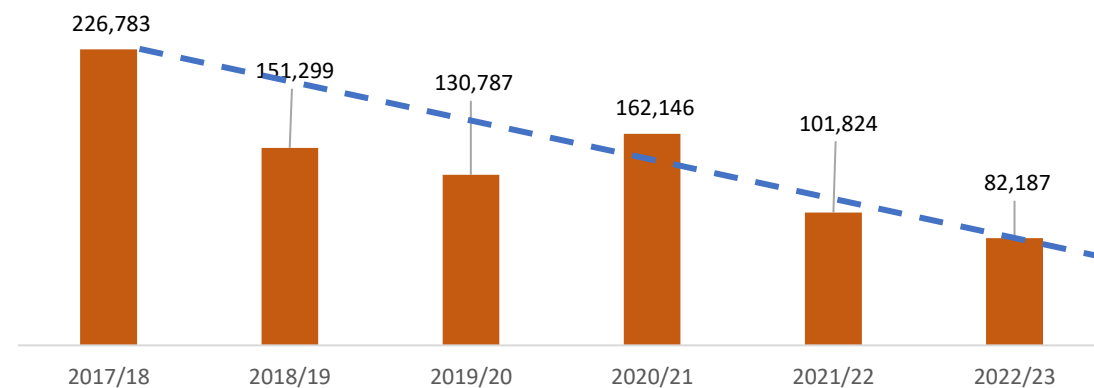

GHANA COCOA PRODUCTION TREND (2017-2023)

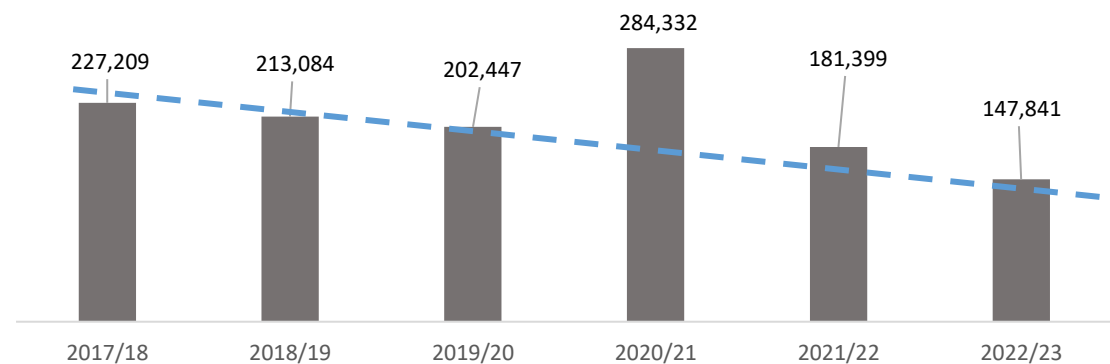


## Regions

WESTERN NORTH REGION (2017-2023)



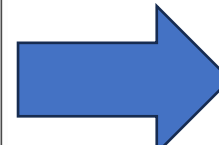
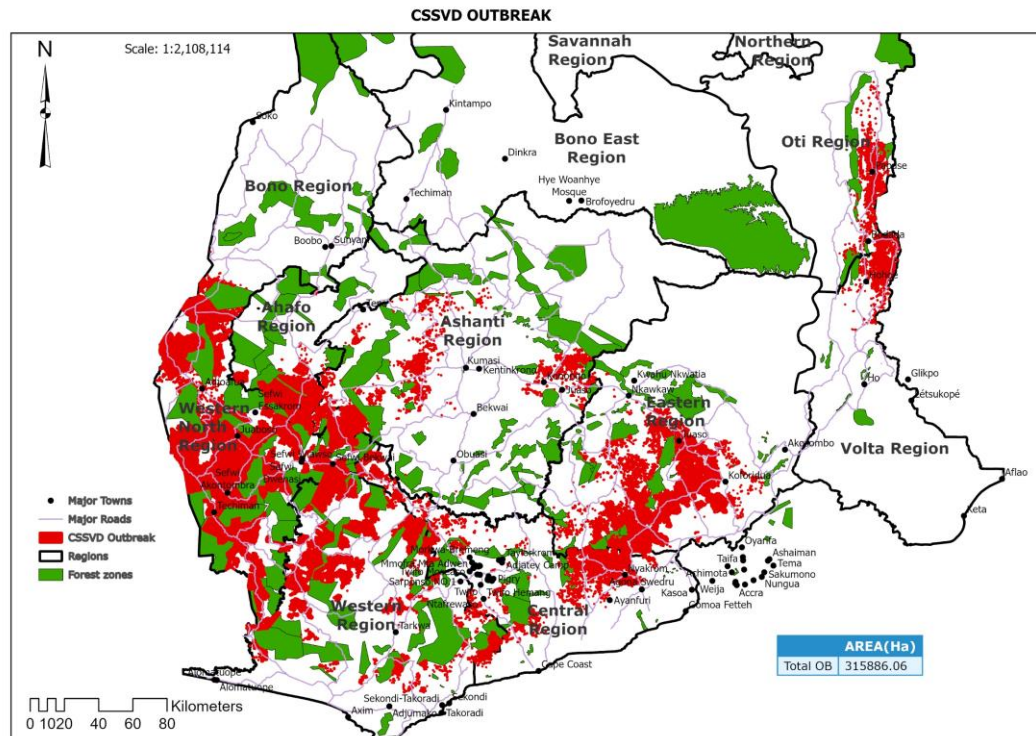
WESTERN SOUTH REGION (2017-2023)



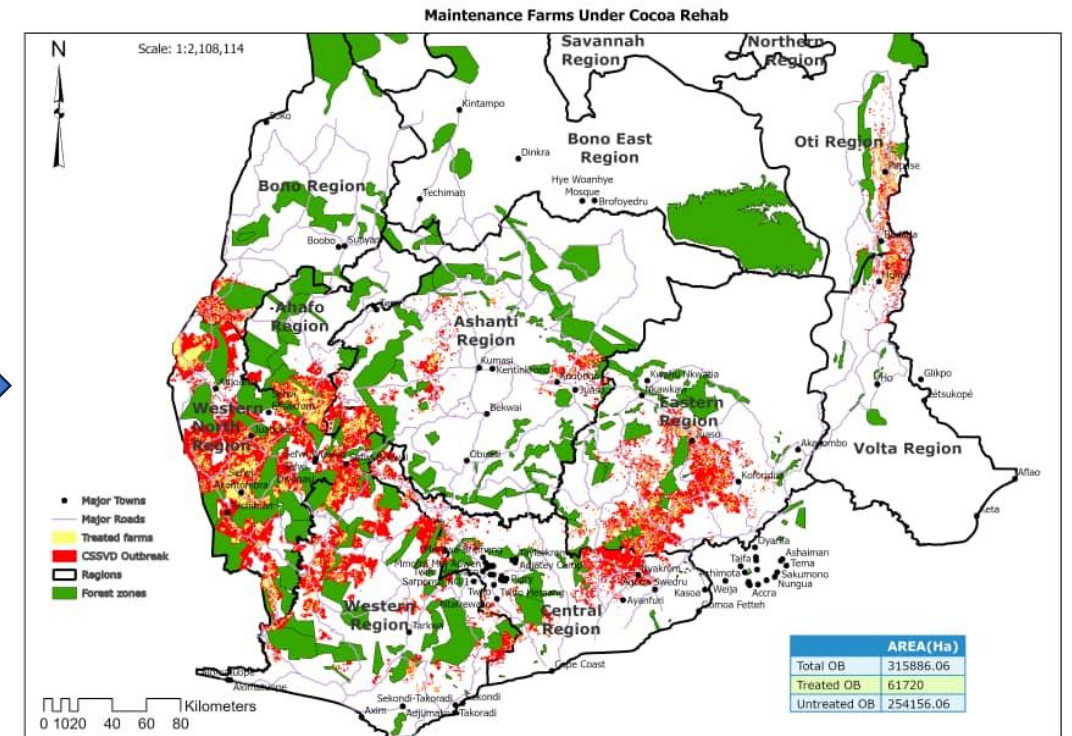


# Extent of CSSVD Infestation and Treatment

## CSSVD OUTBREAK AREAS

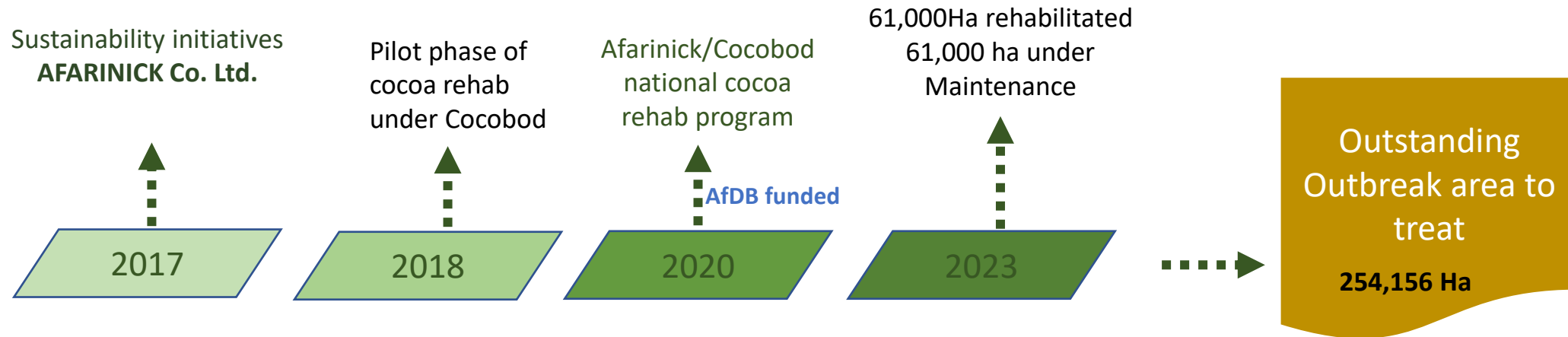




